A LONG VIEW OF 2023 FOR US IN GOLEUDY HARLECH by Martin Wagner

We are completing our first full calendar year as Goleudy Harlech. So, how do we view these early days of our church? Over 600 days (since we 'started' at Easter 2022) of God's sovereign power at work in each of our lives and together as a church family? There are some who been travelling with us for



whom this is very much their experience. God is changing us individually and using us day by day.



Or instead, do we view 2023 as like those early tottering days in a person's life when they are staggering to their feet and taking baby steps? Whether we take a long view or daily view, I see God is at work among us in every perspective of time. Here are a few personal thoughts that I hope encourage you as we reflect on where we are.

Chess board

God is bringing and building together a family of followers of Jesus, in Goleudy Harlech, whom He has individually gifted for a purpose. Call it a team, with a task. Like pieces on a chess board (as a word of prophecy to us describes it), which move in different ways to win the game. Look around at one another. None of us is perfect, but definitely each of us shows the marks of Jesus. Each with a part to play. We come as individuals, together, as church, bringing all our personalities, life experiences, skills, gifts, passions and Christian characters.



Foundations

Some people around us are sceptically waiting for this new church to come and go, like others have done. But we have a vision to be around for as long as God wants us and so are trying to carefully build solid and helpful foundations, that won't be swept away by buffeting storms, doctrinal attack, post-Christian persecution or schism. This year we have started trying to build such foundations including governance, leadership and unity of purpose. It has been hard at times. But I believe we are emerging, through this process, stronger and healthier as a church.

A healing Church

Jesus prayed for unity for his Church so that people would see Him in it. The devil has been busy fragmenting the church into little pieces. But, God has given a wonderful deep heart in Goleudy Harlech people of reaching out to other Christians in our area and gathering around the cross of Jesus where we find our unity. Such inter-church unity is certainly a 'Value' of our church.

This is seen for example in the centrality in our praying on Tuesdays for all the chapels and churches in Ardudwy; in holding the reins of the Meirionnydd Prayer Network to seek God together as churches; and in the remarkable growing of the Men's Breakfast towards an expression of love and unity for Christian men from the area; and a second flourishing community carol service. I think our loving Father is pleased to see his children across the wider church wanting to be together at last! Jesus is fighting back!



Proclaiming Christ

But without love, all this is worthless. It is by our love that we will authentically proclaim that we are following Jesus. In 2023, in our church family, I have seen such a heart of love for bringing the good news of Jesus to others. I have seen so much loving kindness shown to one another.
